For families who have been displaced due to Hurricane Ida, LPSD is offering a virtual learning option. If you have any questions or need assistance in order to apply for virtual learning, please contact your child's school or the school board office. Once a parent has completed the form below, he / she will receive an emailed receipt of the answers submitted on the form. Information concerning virtual learning expectations will be communicated to parents, along with important log in information to confirm registration into the virtual learning program.

Students who are currently enrolled in virtual learning may continue to complete coursework, if able; however, as many families are still without power and internet services, students are not required to register attendance at this time. Parents requesting a MIFI should complete the following form and will be asked to sign a user agreement. After the request is received and approved, the MIFI will be sent to the school for distribution.
